




Place the tag gun through a raised lip at the **INSIDE EDGE** of fabric, along the neck area. Don't go all the way through the back of the fabric or you will make a hole in the clothing.

Before punching the gun, check to make sure the needle is weaved through the thick seam area and no part of the needle is showing through the back of the shirt.



What **NOT** to do!
This will leave a hole if you go straight through the fabric.

Tagging gun barbs punch a hole and tear through fabric



This is how you should safely tag through an inside seam, but make sure you carefully go through the “lip” area on the inside of the shirt and not all the way through the shirt.



Do **NOT** place the tag through an outside seam.

Consignors often miss the seam and cause a hole in the fabric.

Also, the arm pit area is **NOT** the location to place the tag as this area makes it very difficult for us to scan tags and sort items at the end of the sale.



Do **NOT** tag gun an item on a size tag that is located at the bottom of the shirt. This makes it hard to find the tag and scan it quickly. This also makes sorting very slow at the end of the sale.



The **BEST** area to place a tag is directly through the manufacturers tag at the top of the shirt or pants.
